

PANORAMIC VIEWPORTS

The pilots can also sit in the top of the submarine. Its large panoramic viewports give two pilots excellent all-round visibility. Only essential controls have been provided, such as two joysticks, an animated, graphic touch-screen monitor, surface communications, underwater telephone, compass and rudder indicators.



The cockpit has been designed around a two-person crew, with each pilot having a set of throttles, stick and rudder controls, the cockpit is also equipped with double-redundant mission control processors, two multi-functional colour displays for each pilot for a day and night electro-optic system, electronic scanning sonar system and a multi-level system.

The displays are mounted in the shape of a "T" in front of the crew. To save time, and to speed up the process of reconfiguration of the submarine for different dive modes, three master switches are available for diving, for bringing the submarine up to the surface and for starting the diesel engine.
